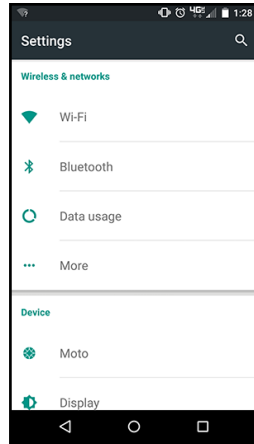


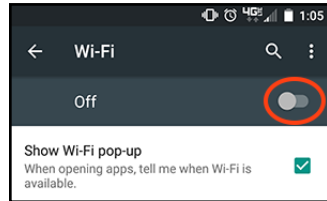


Android Instructions

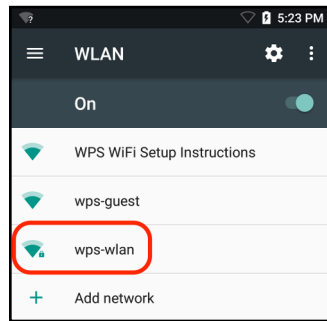
Step 1: Locate your phone's "Settings" area. Depending on your phone version this may be accessible through the top app drawer (via swipe down), from the home screen, or the all apps view icon



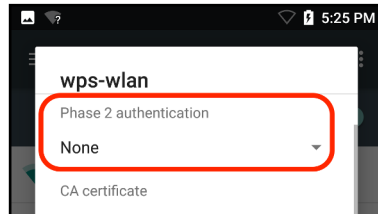
Step 2: Tap "Wi-Fi." If necessary, turn Wi-Fi on



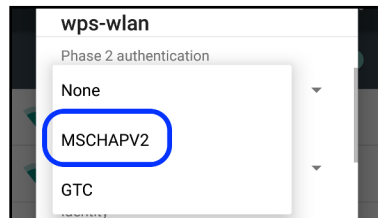
Step 3: Click on "wps-wlan" to connect to the network



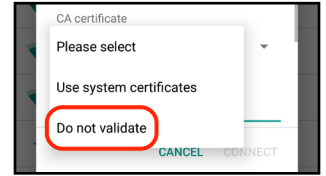
Step 4: Click on "None" under "Phase 2 authentication"



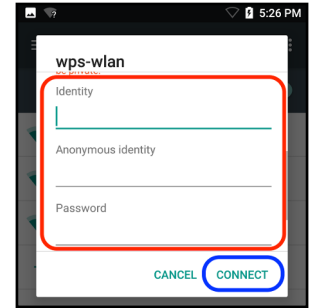
Step 5: From the pop-up menu, select "MSCHAPV2"



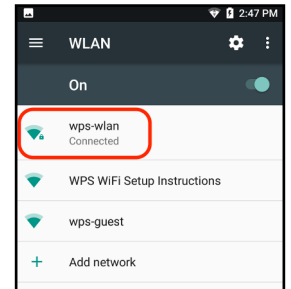
Step 6: In the "Server CA certificate" list, select "Do not validate"



Step 7: In the "Identity" and "Password" field enter your WPS username and password. Then click "Connect"

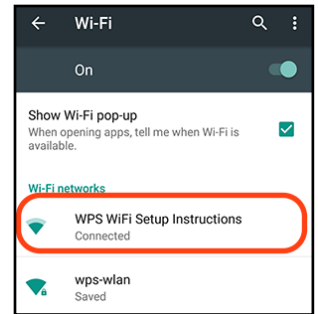


Step 8: Back at the Wi-Fi settings screen, you will see that you are connected to "wps-wlan"



Forget Other Network Connections

Note: If you have previously connected to "wps-guest," "wps-all-aboard", or "WPS WiFi Setup Instructions" they will be listed as "Saved." Press and hold the connection name list entry.



Tap "Forget Network" to remove it from your device. Repeat for any other Saved networks.
